Dear Mr. President

We, the undersigned, call on the Islamic Republic of Iran to release Shane Bauer, Sarah Shourd and Josh Fattal from their protracted detention in Evin Prison without further delay.

The three hikers have been held for four months without charge and without contact with their families, despite your own undertaking more than two months ago to ask the Iranian judiciary to expedite the case and show "maximum leniency."

To continue to detain them without due process raises grave concerns that Iran is holding these three young Americans for political purposes and calls into question Iran's stated commitment to the rule of law.

You have said that Shane, Sarah and Josh entered your country illegally from Iraqi Kurdistan, where they were hiking in an area where the border is poorly marked. We therefore urge Iran to show compassion and release them.

Shane, Sarah and Josh have demonstrated a great commitment to constructing a harmonious world. This commitment is evident from Shane's work as a journalist in the Middle East, Sarah's active support for the rights of women and the underprivileged and Josh's dedication to a sustainable environment, all of which is documented.

We appeal to you to intervene with the judicial authorities so that they may return to their families immediately and resume their lives.
