I am Sandya Ekneligoda, the wife of the journalist Prageeth Ekneligoda who had been disappeared on the 24th of Jan 2010. I am a mother of two sons Sathyajith Sanjaya & Harith Dananjaya. Without any news about my husband, 322 days have being passed until today 13.12.2010.

Two things can be pointed our when I look back. To mention one, on 10th of Feb 2010, at a meeting to present cubinet decisions, the former Media Minister Lakshman Yapa Abeywardana has said information about Prageeth would be given during the coming week. Even though 300 days have passed after that statement any information nor answer was received (The document is attached bout this statement).

On 7° of May at the Supreme Parliament Minister Kehliya Rambukwella stated that he will involve in this matter perdonaly. I am unaware about your participation when 220 days have passed since the day you made this statement.

In the process of education for a child the most important point is the ordinary level examination. Like most of the children especially as sons you must have experienced the courage you received at that moment; through your father's words. His blessingsmust have given you the strength.

Unfortunately our elder son Sanjaya embraced his father's memories while his eyes were moistened with tears at the moment of leaving for examination.

I wish that if you felt you should let my son receive the blessing of his father, which you experienced when you were in his age:

Our second son has now become mentally depressed through the sufferings from the dark memories of the deprivation of the father.

Can you tell me when will my children's suffering come to an end?

I have seen how Kiribath was cooked and wasted all over the country. Can you tell me when can I prepare a dish of kiribath in my house which is in fire since 24.01.2010. When will we be able to sleep peacefully.

My only hope is to hear the voice of my sons calling "thaththa" in front of live

I expect a reply as soon as possible.
